- 12. Splint
- 13. Ice pack
- 14. Hand sanitizer
- 15. First aid guide for reference
- 16. Medication and List with dosage and times taken, and Allergies
- 17. Phone numbers for emergency contact, doctors, pharmacy, poison control, and insurance information
