HOME EVACUATION



Emergency situations may occur, leaving you only minutes to evacuate.

This may be wildfires, floods, earthquakes, gas leaks, toxic chemical spills and others. What may be needed is to evacuate quickly and safely. Before a disaster make preparations like a “Grab N Go Bag” and during one, make decisions based on accurate information.

The most critical decision you will make is whether you are safer in your home, where you have shelter, water, food, utilities and supplies, or on the road, possibly stuck in slow traffic and running out of fuel.

Basic preparedness works for many different kinds of emergencies.
