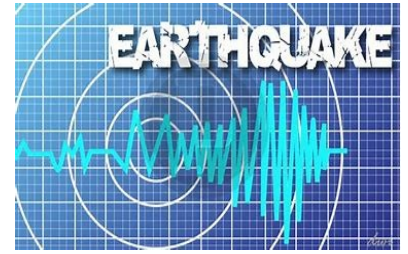

Any questions? Ask our EPC team members who are there to explain.

- ▲ Visit our technology section regarding Air Support (with drones), AM 1620 radio station, HAM radio, Starlink, emergency alerts, apps and websites. Communications and their backups are essential tools in emergency situations.
- ▲ Check out the Search & Rescue section. Find out what they are trained to do to help you in a disaster and what the new Rapid Response Unit is for.
- ▲ Our Medical section has Vial-of-Life available, basic First Aid kits on display, as well as a Grab-N-Go bag and suggestions for their contents. You can sign up for "Stop the Bleed" and "CPR, AED, First Aid" classes given here in Sun City.
- ▲ District maps inform you who your Block Captain is and where your Command Post is located. A Command Post is where the Block Captains report to in a disaster. They have radio communications to request assistance as needed. One third of our homes have Block Captain vacancies. Help your neighborhood by signing up.
- ▲ Other displays help you deal with power outages and extreme heat, control floods with barriers & learn fire safety. Many, many handouts are available, like "Documents," which lists important papers needed after disasters. Check out Pet Rescue for your pet's needs in a disaster. The Emergency Operations Center has tours during ShakeOut.
